


# COMROD APX41-LP

## HF/VHF-band Mobile Whip



### Application:

The APX41 is constructed for land mobile services in the HF/VHF-band 1.5 - 60 MHz. It consists of three whip sections and a base. The base is equipped with heavy duty spring coil to absorb shocks and to allow for a semi permanent deflection of the antenna when moving the vehicle. To give better performance on lower frequencies, it is possible to add up to three more sections. On higher VHF frequencies one section can be removed to give a better radiation pattern.


Design	End fed whip. Radiating elements completely enclosed in epoxy/fibreglass laminate. Metal parts are brass and stainless steel.
